Special Notice:

Due to the continual need to think about COVID 19 mitigation measures, and to protect the health of our shooters and officials, the following measures will be taken during these matches:

- Per City of Calgary bylaw starting on September 23, businesses, entities and events must require proof of vaccination, negative test result or a medical exemption letter from patrons. The following was provided by the City:

PROOF OF VACCINATION

3. (1) **A person must not enter or remain in the premises of an eligible business**, unless the person provides personal identification and one of the following:

- (a) proof of vaccination;
- (b) proof of a negative COVID-19 test result from a sample that is taken within the prior 72 hours; or
- (c) an original vaccine medical exception letter; to the operator or proprietor of the eligible business.

- Athletes should show up no earlier than 30 minutes before being called to the line.
- Everyone entering the CRPC must wear a mask. The City of Calgary's mandatory face covering bylaw is still in effect in indoor public spaces.
- Athletes must provide and wear a mask until they reach their firing point, at which time they may remove the mask while shooting (shooter's choice).
- Line officials will wear a mask at all times.
- Athletes are responsible for hand hygiene while in the building and on the firing line. CRPC is not responsible for providing wipes, hand sanitizer or gloves.
- Washrooms are open for use.
- People waiting in the clubhouse must adhere to provincial and city regulations, and maintain social distancing. Due to limited space, spectators (including parents) should consider waiting outside or in their vehicles.
- The barriers between shooting positions is impermeable; this allows us to use every shooting position, as long as masks are worn to and from the position.
- Regrettably, no proof of vaccination or negative test means that the athlete cannot compete.
